For area A1 and A2, at least one (1) officer on Deck Department to be in possession of valid General Operator Certificate (G.O.C). For area A1+A2+A3, at least two officers on Deck Department with General Operator Certificate (GOC) or one dedicated radio officer with GOC.

 All vessels 500 GT or more, engaged in international voyages should have on board at least one qualified Ship Security Officer.
 If total number of crew is ten (10) or more, vessels should be

additionally manned with one fully qualified Cook

Special Requirement:

- Watchkeeping arrangements shall be at the discretion of the Master but shall never be of lesser standards than those prescribed by
  the STCW Convention and IMO Resolution A.1047(27). The grade and numbers of personnel listed above reflect the minimum levels of
  manning necessary for the safety of navigation and operation. Additional personnel as may be considered necessary for maintenance,
  or cargo handling and control, or watch keeping, and as needed for required rest periods, are the responsibility of the owners, Master,
  and Chief Engineer.
- If classed for periodically unattended machinery operation, shall provide a record of satisfactory Automation Notation survey is completed
  in accordance with the Classification Society requirements
- Crew members on any type of tanker are required to hold certificates of proficiency as per requirements of STCW: Regulation V/I-1 &V/I-2.

Special Conditions: "It is shipowner's and master's responsibility to propose the safe composition of crew, this state can take it for granted that the above manning scale proposal has been done by them after having taken in consideration ship's and voyage's special requirements. The master should take the necessary measures to apply resting hours regulations, for the safety on board the vessel and the fitness for duty as well."
